Treasurer's Report for year ended 31 December 2022

Subscription income was almost the same as in the previous year, but donations fell by nearly 40%, probably because the immediate threats posed to the Wood by the initial flood prevention scheme receded. We did, on the other hand, receive a grant from Haringey Council towards the cost of the Family Fun Day. Overall our income for the year was just under £3800, 6 ½% less than in 2021.

We spent a further £1800 on legal advice about the flood prevention scheme in addition to the £2200 we spent the previous year. This was an expense we would have preferred not to incur, but it served its purpose of ensuring that the council took our concerns seriously.

On a happier note, we were pleased to be able to resume a more normal level of activities after the interruption caused by the Covid-19 pandemic. We were pleased to hold a Family Fun Day again at a net cost to us after the grant of just under £400. We were also able to restart our programme of surveys of the wildlife in the Wood – a newt survey cost £216 and we set in hand a bird survey, where the expenditure of £1400 will fall into next year. We were able to return to a more usual level of guided walks and paid for a number of minor works in the Wood to supplement the work we do in our working parties. Our administrative costs and publicity costs also increased as our activity level returned to normal after the pandemic.

As a result, our total expenditure exceeded our income for the year by £562. By and large, it was good to see past accumulated surpluses being put to good use for renewed activities. Our reserves remain very healthy at nearly £8000 and there is no need to increase subscriptions, notwithstanding the high level of inflation in the current year.
